Know Your Rights as a sponsored parolee/refugee

You Have Rights

A sponsor should not **pressure** you or give you **ultimatums**:

| To live with them | | To give them your documents |
| To work for them | | To be intimate with them |



Red Flags

If Sponsor says:

I live **FAR** from the city

There's **NO transportation** around me

I have a big farm, family or business-I will need **help**



Sponsor Can't

END your sponsorship | **Deport** you

Force you to learn English, or say it is **MANDATORY**

Take your paycheck | **Force you to work for them**



You are **NOT** obligated to:

Repay your sponsor | **Live** with your sponsor

Work for your sponsor (coercion or free labor)

Give your sponsor your original **documents** (passport/birth certificate)

Put up with any sort of **sexual advances** (touching, kissing or sexual acts)



Don't be Afraid | Don't be Ashamed

In case of any hint of **FORCED LABOR** or **FORCED SEXUAL RELATIONSHIP** from your sponsor, you should leave immediately and seek shelter at the nearest hospital, clinic, domestic violence shelter, place of worship or the police.
